Kratom	Not scheduled	Opioid withdrawal	Primary	Anecdotal
LSD	Schedule I	Anxiety in patients with life-threatening illness	Primary	Case reports
MDMA	Schedule I	PTSD	Primary	Phase 2 trials
Psilocybin	Schedule I	Depression, anxiety due to life-threatening illness	Primary	Phase 1 trials
