Vilazodone (Viibryd)	10 mg	40 mg	Stimulation, nausea	Take with food to improve absorption.		
Vortioxetine (Trintellix)	5 mg	20 mg	Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, constipation	SSRI-like properties.		
Levomilnacipran (Fetzima)	20 mg	120 mg	Constipation, sweating	Isomer of fibromyalgia drug milnacipran (Savella).		
Antipsychotics						
Aripiprazole (Abilify)	2.5 mg	10 mg	Stimulation, dizziness, nausea	Minimal weight gain; approved as antidepressant augmentation.		
Lurasidone (Latuda)	20 mg	40 mg	Restlessness, nausea	Minimal weight gain; approved for bipolar depression. Take with food (at least 350 calories) to increase bioavailability.
