Heroin	Semisynthetic from morphine, 1874	illicit	H, dope, smack, horse, black tar	Wide variability due to adulteration
Hydrocodone	Semisynthetic from codeine, 1920	Vicodin, Lortab, Norco	Vikes, hykes	30 mg oral
Hydromorphone	Semisynthetic from morphine, 1924	Dilaudid	Dillies, D-lights, beans, drug-store dope	7.5 mg oral
Meperidine	Synthetic, 1939	Demerol, Mepergan	Demmies	300 mg oral
Methadone	Synthetic, 1937	Dolophine, Methadose	Meth, biscuits, fizzies	20 mg (acute), 2–4 mg (chronic) oral
Morphine	Opium poppy, 1804	MSContin, Oramorph, Roxanol	Morpho, Dreamer, Mister Blue, God's drug	30 mg oral
Oxycodone	Semisynthetic from thebaine, 1917	Percocet, OxyContin	Oxy, OC, percs, hillbilly heroin	20 mg oral
