Nicotine lozenge	2–4 mg every 1–2 hours as needed	Headache, indigestion, nausea
Varenicline (Chantix)	Start 0.5 mg/day, increase to 1 mg twice daily	Insomnia, vivid dreams
Bupropion (Wellbutrin, Zyban)	150 mg, either once or twice daily	Tremor, insomnia, weight loss
